Iain Stewart dispels the myth of the difficulty of watercolor, emphasizing that in fact, it is a creative outlet unmatched for its ease of use, cost of materials, and artistic expression. His sole focus in this workshop is your creativity! Students of all levels of skill and experience are welcome.

Learn the process of simplifying subject matter with exploratory sketching and value studies. His repeatable process of planned steps improves studio, as well as plein air painting. Paint from life and from photographs (provided by instructor). Experienced painters may use their photographs. With ample one-on-one instruction and thoughtful critique, the focus is on the student and not how well the instructor can paint.

Iain Stewart is a signature member of both the American and National Watercolor Societies amongst many others. His work has received top awards in international competition. In addition to working as a fine artist and workshop instructor, Iain is an architectural illustrator with an international clientele and an Adjunct Professor at the School of Architecture at Auburn University. His workshops are very popular, and he has had long experience in teaching and interacting with students.
